

ADM-IE Report

October 1, 2014

This report was held back at the request of Infrastructure and Environment, due to it likely containing information not yet distributed to their chain of command. However, it is now time to share it. The content is obviously dated.

The Core Task analysis that was being done by Esquimalt and Borden is no more as it was realized through that process that the very definition is problematic and as a result the outcome will be flawed. A macro working group will be stood up to define this work and the ToRs should be ready for discussion mid-Oct, and the Unions will be invited to be part of this. Early discussion was around the definition of Core Task as being “that which must be done in-house”. The early Tiger Teams identified some 400 +/- tasks which are to be considered. We asked a question pertaining to the DRDCs – particularly in Quebec, and we were told that the person best able to respond to our org chart/super-tech questions was on leave till Oct 10 and that he would do this upon his return. I have not as yet heard either way from the region. Pg 3 of the IOC plus presentation has 2 points of note: the ICCT discussion was being reviewed that week and would be followed up the week of the 6th. And the RCN is to transfer the Mil FH in Shearwater to the RCAF

Pg 4 of the Real Property Resp presentation: “RPCC” stands for Real Property Coordination Committee, and the RCN expressed concerns on who actually decides the space allocation. It will be IE based on standards but with their input.

Pg 13 was around the redesign of the W/BCEs through a working group that will involve the Unions.

Pg 14 led to the discussion around classification compression and we were told that HR Classification will be coming out with a communication piece around it, but for now, there are no compression fears. And “FDO” stands for Facilities Development Officer”.
