Collective Bargaining

The notice to bargain was submitted on Oct 19 2011. We are off to a slow start as John Sullivan announced on our first day at the table that he was in retiring Jan 2012. His replacement has been announced as Hassan Hussein. The clearance process has begun and bargaining will continue with the unclassified business to be dealt with first. John will mentor until his retirement.

Dates have been scheduled for a week in late Jan 2012.

LTA/MTA

The move to the MTA is scheduled to happen on Nov 28 2011. OSH has identified some issues that will need to be corrected prior to the move.

At a recent meeting of the LTA Oversight committee it was announced that of the 91 positions affected by the PPP, 10 more positions have been removed from the list and the number of staff who may not be placed within our organization will be 1-5. There is discussion taking place within the GoC S& I community to find positions for those members. As these people already have clearances it is felt by management that this should not be a difficult task.
