

**Young Workers Initiative Committee report**

Since the UNDE convention, I've attempted on two occasions to set up conference calls of the reps without success.

Although some regional reps think the momentum was there and I should have capitalized on this, there are other variables that make up a successful committee. One should always strive for consensus and if for any reason a rep is unable to participate then the conference call or meeting should be postponed for a more convenient time whereby everyone can participate.

Furthermore the discussion to change the age limit from 30 to 35 is continuing, however there has been no concrete action to date.

In my discussion with the OPI for the young worker (PSAC NCR), a resolution to the PSAC Convention could have ensured the change, however he indicated that young worker participated at the regional level up to the age of 35 if they so chose.
