Labour College of Canada Certificate Program Online Session Part II - April-June 2018

The Labour College of Canada (LCC) is a union-made education program for active union members. The new LCC Certificate Program is a labour studies and leadership program for labour active union members that supports critical thinking and collaborative learning in a flexible format.

The program is now divided into three sessions. Each session includes an on-line and in-person component. All sessions require preparation and reading and some work following each session related to an independent project (LCC Project). The LCC Certificate Program:

- Builds leadership skills and provides leadership tools
- Fosters empowerment, self-confidence and new networks of labour leaders
- Strengthens critical thinking skills
- Examines working class struggles and human rights issues that affect all workers
- Creates change!
